Hey everybody!

It has been a while, or more like a long while; I know haha. I think I should get an award for the most inconsistent blogger on planet earth haha. But here I am, once again, but I think this will be the last episode of a 7 month drama.

I think I last blogged just after I had my last chemo session (just to recap: it was a tough one and I was seriously happy when I finished). Then I had a week off and during this week I took part in Mej CPUT (Miss CPUT - my campus's beauty pageant type thing). It was such an amazing night for me, I loved every minute of doing it and I felt so proud that I could stand up on a stage and dance and parade around with confidence even after losing my hair and after going through all the chemo etc. I won Mej Kampus (Miss Campus) that night. It meant the absolute world to me to know that my peers had voted for me and that they supported me so much and throughout everything. It was a wonderful night and I proved to myself and any other person suffering from cancer that anything is possible if you keep positive and never give up.

The week off was glorious haha but it soon ended and then my radiation started. I went for a scan just before I started the treatment and the doctor told me that she saw nothing on the scan, which meant that I was pretty much in remission. The radiation was just a precaution.

I went for radiation everyday for 10 minutes. It was hectic. I would usually finish class at 13:00 then Andries and I would drive an hour through to Somerset West. I would have the radiation then we would jump back in the car and drive back seeing as I had things to do every afternoon. I would not recommend this to anyone. It sucks haha and it's seriously tiring, but on the other hand I never had enough time to actually think about it haha. I was just on the go the whole time and I wouldn't have wanted it any other way. The radiation process wasn't too bad. All I basically had to do was lie down. But I had to have a plastic mask hold me down in one place to make certain that they radiated only specific points, and that wasn't nice. The mask was so tight and very very uncomfortable. I must say I have now mastered the art of visualising myself on a beach somewhere haha. That's the

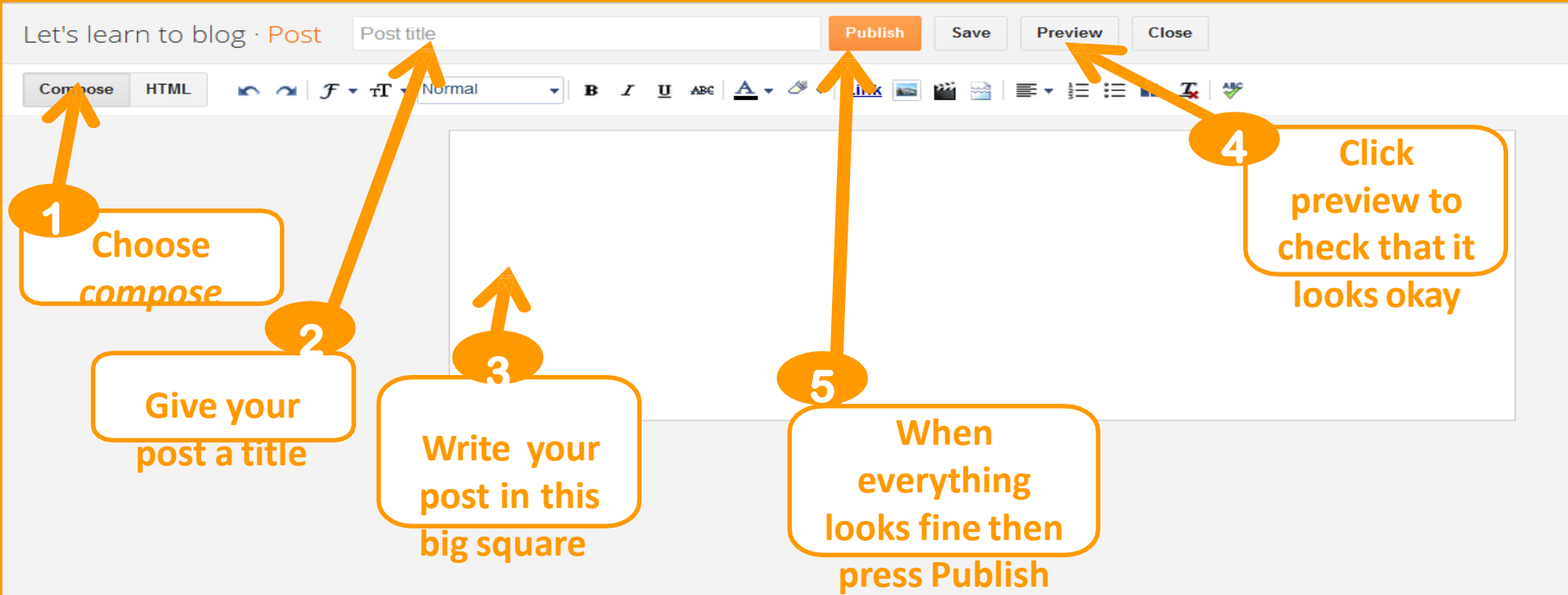
